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# Brief introduction about VNU USSH, Hanoi

- VNU University of Social Sciences and Humanities (USSH), Hanoi was founded in 1945.
- Currently comprises 16 faculties, a university affiliated institute, a museum, a limited liability company, and 15 research centers.
- 537 faculties and staff (9 full professors, 93 associate professors, 206 PhD holders).

## Brief introduction about VNU USSH, Hanoi

- Nearly 10,000 domestic and international students.
- Hosts about 800 international students annually.
- 23 Bachelor programs; 32 Master programs; 28 PhD programs.
- Double degree programs.

# Brief introduction about VNU USSH, Hanoi

- Has had partnership with more than 200 international academic institutions and agencies, including Princeton University, University of California, University of Paris, Toulouse I and II Universities, MGU, Humboldt University, University of Tokyo, University of Seoul, Beijing University, National University of Singapore, etc.
- Series of lectures and seminars with international visiting professors and experts and many international conferences.

### **Potentials**

- Many programs highly popular with both Vietnamese and international students, including Vietnamese studies and language, Linguistics, Oriental Studies, International Studies, Journalism and Communication, Management Science, Psychology, Sociology, Tourism, etc.
- Being a prestigious academic institution, domestically and internationally.
- Good partnership, cooperation with many universities around the world.

#### **Current situation**

- Receiving international students to USSH:
  - Format: 2+2 or 3+1 programs, short-term exchange programs or courses, postgraduate study, etc.

- Sending USSH students abroad:
  - Format: Short-term exchange programs or courses, 2+2 programs, 1-year course, etc.

#### Issues

- In receiving international students to USSH:
  - No credit-based or full time programs delivered fully in English;
  - Low compatibility between the curricula of some programs offered in USSH and of those offered by universities from other countries.
  - Learning environment needs improvement;
  - Not enough activities to attract students via the media and communication channels.
- For sending USSH students abroad as full-time or credit students:
  - Difficulties in meeting foreign languages demands;
  - Financial problems.

## Perspectives

- Globalization and growing international integration lead to increased movement of labor. Academic and training institutions, thus, need to focus on producing "global citizens".
- Many programs, projects offering financial support to facilitate international student exchange and the internationalization of curricula, from which Vietnam, in general, and USSH, in particular, benefit. These include EU Share, Erasmus Plus, PEACE, etc.

## Solutions

- For issues in receiving students:
  - Developing curricula, programs fully in English;
  - Improving learning environment and living facilities for international students;
  - Enhancing promotion activities through the media;
  - Expanding activities such as summer school, study tour, internship, etc.
- For issues in sending USSH students abroad:
  - Diversifying the sources of student financial support (apart from scholarships from partner universities, funding from businesses and agencies with subsequent job commitment can also be seek);
  - Strengthening measures to improve students' foreign language capacity.
