

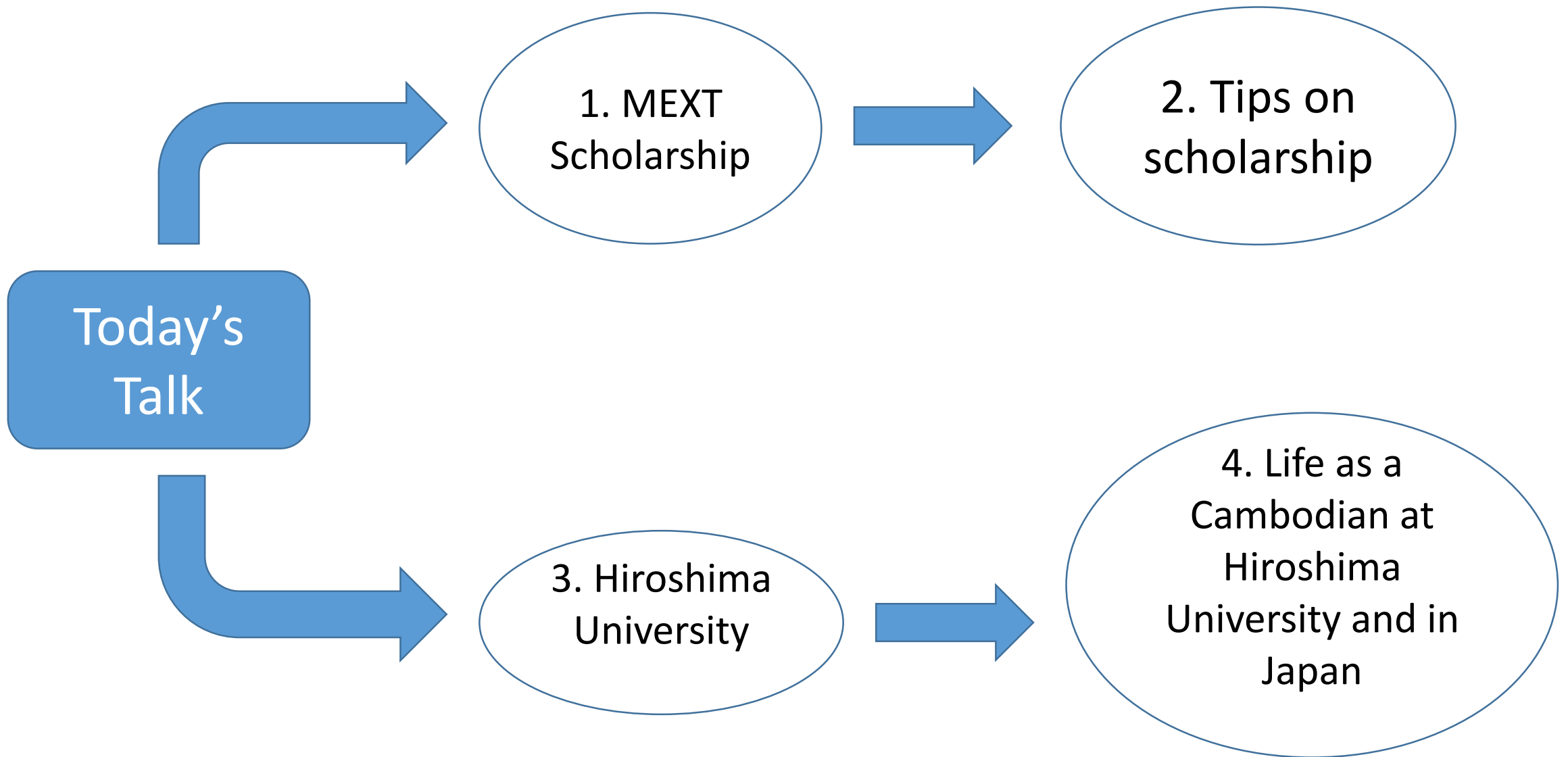

- **ការប្រឡងប្រជែង៖** ភាសា, ចំណេះដឹងទូទៅ និងសមត្ថភាពបញ្ញា, ចំណេះដឹងជំនាញ, ភាពដែលអាចរស់នៅ និងសិក្សាបាន...

About MEXT scholarship (Tips)

- បង្កើនជំនាញ និងចំណេះដឹងផ្នែកស្រាវជ្រាវ (research methods, academic reading and writing...)
- ពង្រឹង academic background knowledge ក្នុងផ្នែកគណិតសាស្ត្រ វិទ្យាសាស្ត្រ និងបច្ចេកវិទ្យា
- ស្វែងយល់ពីចំណេះដឹងស្តីជម្រៅទាក់ទងនឹងប្រធានបទអាកាដេមិចណាមួយ (e.g. understanding supervisor's research area; having a clear sense of one's own academic direction; understanding career track and life as a scholar...) និងចេះប្រមូល និងគ្រប់គ្រងធនធាន (organizational skills, seeking advises from mentors...)
- សមត្ថភាពរៀនដោយឯករាជ្យ (English, technology, learning how to learn, MOOCs and other online training programs...)
- ចេះសិក្សា និងឆ្លុះបញ្ចាំងពីជីវិត និងអារ្យធម៌ (Japanese way of thinking, Japanese culture and language... the idea of system, planning, discipline, industriousness, innovation, tolerance, peace and tranquility...)

- Socializing...

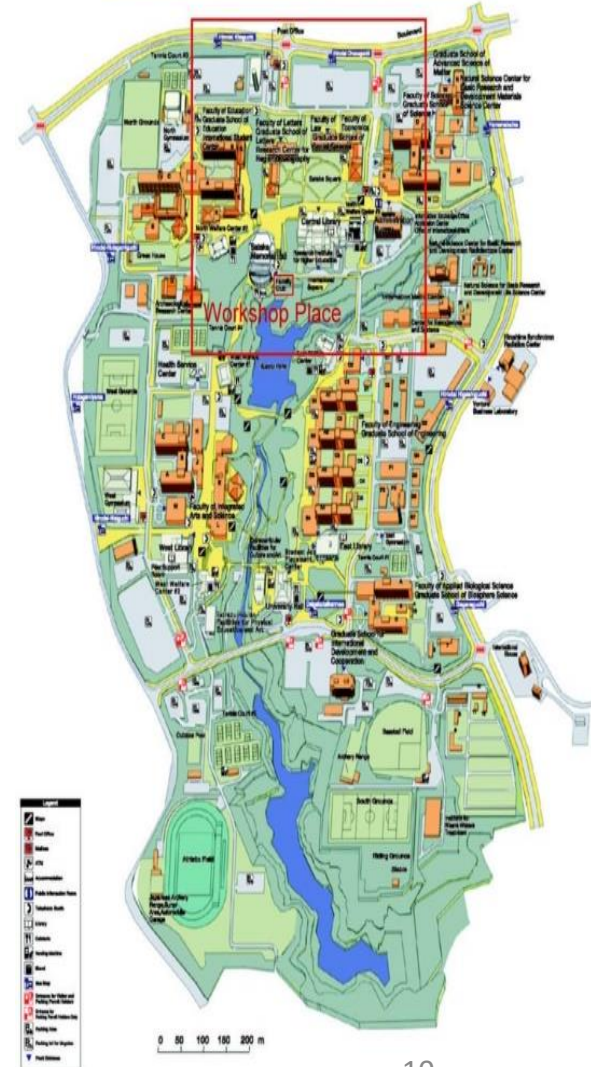
Some personal experience in Hiroshima:
